### 2nd meeting of 2020 ReinHerit - 28 & 29 March 2022

The Bank of Cyprus Cultural Foundation, as major coordinator of the ReinHerit project, on 28 and 29 March held the first live meeting since the launch of the programme.

The meeting, which took place in the BOCCF facilities, was opened by Dr Ioanna Hadjicosti, project coordinator. In her address, Dr Hadjicosti said she was proud of the smooth running of the programme and the harmonious collaboration among its partners. The partners went on to make presentations of the programme's course and development.

The following also participate in ReinHerit as partners: Cycladic Museum and Blue Shield from Greece; the University of Florence - MICC, Florence, Italy and Consorzio Materahub Industrie Culturali e Creative from Italy; ASOCIACIÓN ARTE SOSTENIBLE from Spain, the University of Graz (Austrian Centre for Digital Humanities) and STadmuseum GrazGmbH from Austria; the European Cultural Tourism Network from Belgium; the Arcada University of Applied Sciences from Finland; and the University of Nicosia (School of Law) and the Research Centre of Interactive Media Smart Systems and Emerging Technologies (CYENS) from Cyprus.

## The CulturEU funding guide



The European Commission recently published the interactive guide CulturEU, which maps all 2021-2027 EU level funding available for the cultural and creative sectors. It gathers 75 funding opportunities from 21 different funding programmes and offers inspiring best cases examples.

The guide has been developed to help all types and sizes of partners working in the cultural and creative sectors to navigate the EU funding landscape, to understand which opportunities are available to them, and ultimately help them to access EU funding more easily. CulturEU will be regularly updated with the most recent information about new funding calls and by early 2022 it will be available in all EU languages.
